



SLD Class Book Information 2020

The Class Teacher will assess your child's level at the beginning of the year and purchase books when assessments are complete-cost outlined in table below.

The School runs a book rental scheme: The terms of the scheme are as follows for 2020/2021

Deposit €10 which will be refunded to you in June 2021 or rolls over to the following year when the books have been returned in good condition. If however, a book is lost or damaged so that it may not be used by another pupil, this deposit will go towards replacing the book. This deposit is payable in June/September.

Rental Fee €12: This is the cost for participating in the scheme in order to ensure that the book rental scheme is sustainable. This fee is payable before the Summer Holidays or no later beginning of September.
